# TRANSMITTAL OF THE FEDERAL FACILITY AGREEMENT PROPOSED APPENDIX J

Enclosed is the U.S. Department of Energy Oak Ridge Office of Environmental Management proposed Fiscal Year (FY) 2023 Federal Facility Agreement for the Oak Ridge Reservation (FFA), Appendix J, Section XVIII.B.1, Scoping Work Priorities, submittal for your review.

Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act project work, funded by the National Nuclear Security Administration or Office of Science, will not be included in this annual submittal but added case-by-case for projects that will continue into the Appendix J FY+3 or FY+4 timeframe.

The U.S. Department of Energy anticipates some out-year milestone rearrangements to take place after current contract negotiations for future cleanup work are completed in June 2023. Please keep in mind that we will have the opportunity in September 2023 to roll out-year milestones into the enforceable Appendix E.

Review and approval of the FY 2026 and FY 2027 proposed Appendix J Non-Enforceable Out-Year Planning Targets will follow the FFA Appendix I-16 process. Enclosure 2 reflects the referenced time frame for this process. If there are Appendix I-16 schedule modifications necessary this year, the changes will be agreed upon by the three FFA Project Managers.


