The Environmental Protection Agency has completed its review of the Addendum to the Phased Construction Completion Report (PCCR) for Building K-29 of the Remaining Facilities Demolition Project at the East Tennessee Technology Park (ETTP) (DOE/OR/01-2336&D2/A1), which was submitted by the Department of Energy (DOE) on October 18, 2016. The EPA received the document on October 26, 2016.

The document provides information on the change in the end state of the remaining Building K-29 concrete slab, which was used by DOE to support the demolition of other buildings at ETTP. The slab is classified as a potentially radiological and chemically contaminated structure. Due to the residual contamination, the slab will be managed in accordance with Appendix K of the Remedial Design Report/Remedial Action Work Plan for Zone 2 Soils, Slabs, and Subsurface Structures (DOE/OR/01-2224&D5) until the slab is removed from the soil zone.
